CITY RESOLUTION NO. 189-2015

RESOLUTION DECLARING A STATE OF CALAMITY IN TUGUEGARAO CITY DUE TO DAMAGES CAUSED BY FLOODING IN THE AFTERMATH OF TYPHOON NONA

WHEREAS, Section 458 (1) (iv) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall “adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities, and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and in their return to productive livelihood following said events”;

WHEREAS, the low-lying areas of Tuguegarao City were flooded in the aftermath of Typhoon Nona;

WHEREAS, due to flooding, residents and livestock were evacuated to higher grounds and crops were destroyed;

WHEREAS, the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council had an emergency meeting on December 18, 2015 and passed Council Resolution No. 06, series of 2015, recommending that Tuguegarao City be declared under a state of calamity due to the damages caused by flooding due to heavy rains spawned by Typhoon Nona;

WHEREAS, to expedite rescue, recovery, relief and rehabilitation efforts, a state of national calamity has been declared by President Benigno Simeon C. Aquino III;

WHEREAS, this Resolution is pursuant to Memo Order No. 04, series of 1998 of the National Disaster Coordinating Council which enumerates the criteria for Calamity Area Declaration;


WHEREAS, the remaining balance of P3.9M from the Quick Response Fund shall be used, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
