CITY ORDINANCE NO.05-2016

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE TUGUEGARAO CITY YOUTH BRASS BAND
AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR**

WHEREAS, Section 2 (b) of Republic Act No. 8044 "Youth in National Building Act" directs the "Mobilization of youth's abilities, talents and skills...";

WHEREAS, there is a need to discover, develop and promote the musical inclinations of the youth of Tuguegarao City;

WHEREAS, one of these musical avenues is the creation of a brass band that will involve youth's active participation;

WHEREAS, a brass band is indispensable during city fiesta celebrations, arrival of dignitaries, programs and other similar activities;

WHEREAS, the existence of the brass band shall also enable to save the youth from the influence of habit-forming drugs and juvenile practices;

WHEREAS, the Tuguegarao City Government supports the creation and funding of the band to promote a productive life of the youth of Tuguegarao City.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED by the Sixth City Council of Tuguegarao in session assembled, to enact:

CHAPTER 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "*An Ordinance Creating the Tuguegarao City Youth Brass Band and Providing Funds Therefor.*"

SECTION 2. OBJECTIVES. The Brass Band which shall be known as the Tuguegarao City Youth Brass Band shall endeavor to:

- a. Discover, develop and promote the musical inclinations of the Youth of Tuguegarao City;
- b. Promote Tuguegarao culture by requiring their presence during city fiesta celebrations, arrival of dignitaries, programs and other similar activities;
- c. Enable to save the youth from the influence of habit-forming drugs and juvenile practices; and,
- d. Assist the brass band members finish their studies through a financial assistance.

CHAPTER 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS

SECTION 3. Whenever used in this Ordinance, the following terms hereunder shall mean:

- a. **Brass Band** – is a musical ensemble generally consisting entirely of brass instruments, most often with a percussion section such as trumpet, cornet, trombone, french horn, baritone, euphonium, tenor horn and tuba
- b. **Grantee** – a qualified member of the brass band who enjoys/receives financial assistance
- c. **Trainor/Trainer** – one who shall properly guide and train the members of the brass band

SECTION 5. QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS – Members of the Brass Band shall be:

- a. Bonafide residents of Tuguegarao City
- b. With parental consent
- c. Know how to play at least one musical instrument of the brass band
- d. Willing to undergo trainings and rehearsals
- e. High school and college students and not more than twenty-two (22) years old
- f. Comply with the following requirements:
 1. Barangay Clearance
 2. Police Clearance
 3. School Registration or valid Assessment Form
 4. An undertaking that the applicant is not a grantee of any scholarship or study grant

SECTION 6. DUTIES – Members of the Brass Band shall:

- a. Attend actively and participate in trainings, rehearsals and actual performances
- b. Maintain good scholastic records
- c. Develop further their musical talents

CHAPTER 4. DUTIES OF THE BRASS BAND TRAINOR

SECTION 7. The Trainor who specializes in music or related courses shall have the following duties:

- a. To train and guide members
- b. To see to it that members are ready for actual performances
- c. To strictly check the attendance of members as basis for their financial assistance and allowance
- d. To act as guardian during approved trainings, rehearsals and actual performances
- e. To determine the capacity of members to continue as grantees

- f. To screen applicants

CHAPTER 5. STUDENTS AND TRAINOR/TRAINER BENEFITS

SECTION 8. The members and the trainor of the brass band are entitled to:

A. Members

1. Educational Financial Assistance at Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) per semester

B. Trainor

1. Monthly honorarium of Three Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (P3,600.00)

CHAPTER 6. RECRUITMENT AND SUPERVISION

SECTION 9. SUPERVISION – The Office of the City Mayor shall have the direct supervision over the brass band.

SECTION 10. RECRUITMENT – Prospective Members shall write a letter addressed to the City Mayor for their intention to become Members of the band.

- a. The applicants shall undergo the screening process to be facilitated by the trainor.

CHAPTER 7. MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS AND VENUE

SECTION 11. MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS – The Office of the City Mayor shall enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the principal of Cagayan National High School for the use of their existing band instruments and venue of rehearsals during the first year of its operation until such time the city shall procure the needed instruments.

A one-time incidental expense for the purchase of reeds/needed instruments as well as Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00) for repair of instruments shall be provided.

SECTION 12. VENUE – The Office of the City Mayor shall designate an area at the People's Gymnasium as its permanent venue for rehearsals.

CHAPTER 8. APPROPRIATIONS

SECTION 13. Funding for the Brass Band shall be provided in the next Supplemental Budget and the Annual Budget of the City Government hereafter.

CHAPTER 9. FINAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be separable and in the event that one or more of the provisions are held illegal or unconstitutional, the validity of the other provisions shall not be affected.


SECTION 15. REPEALING CLAUSE Ordinances, executive order and other local legislations inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby modified or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and in accordance with the provisions of the Local Government Code.

On motion of Hon. Aurora A. Ave, duly seconded by Hon. Estelita U. Dayag and Hon. Perla C. Tumulitan and without any objection, **CITY ORDINANCE NO.05-2016** was **UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED** on its Second, Third and Final Reading under suspended rules.


