

CITY ORDINANCE NO. 17-2016

CITY ORDINANCE SUSPENDING THE EXISTING TRAFFIC ORDINANCE AND ADOPTING THE EXPERIMENTAL TRAFFIC SCHEME FOR SIXTY (60) DAYS STARTING ON NOVEMBER 01, 2016 TO DECEMBER 31, 2016

SECTION 1. OBJECTIVE. This Ordinance shall govern the efficient and effective flow of people, goods and conveyances through the road networks as well as providing measures for an effective traffic management of the City of Tuguegarao. This Ordinance will suspend the existing traffic scheme to pave way for the experimental traffic scheme for sixty (60) days starting on November 01, 2016 to December 31, 2016.

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. This Ordinance shall govern all types of vehicles and conveyances including single motorcycles.

For purposes of this Ordinance, Poblacion shall refer to Barangays covering Centro 01 to 12, Ugac Sur, Ugac Norte, and parts of Caritan Centro and San Gabriel, except in barangays and areas located along diversion road from Balzain junction to Buntun Highway.

SECTION 3. ONE WAY STREETS

1. Along Campos Street starting Diversion Road to College Avenue
2. Along Bagay Road starting corner Andrews Street to College Avenue
3. Along Taft Street starting College Avenue to Lecaros Street
4. Along Mabini Street starting College Avenue
5. Along Burgos Street (from Gomez Street to Lecaros Street)
6. Along Bonifacio Street starting corner College Avenue to Arellano Street
7. Along Valenzuela Street starting Gonzaga Street to Arellano Street
8. Along Rizal Street starting from Arellano Street to College Avenue
9. Along Blumentritt Street starting from Arellano Street to Rizal Street
10. Along Burgos Street (from Gonzaga Street to College Avenue)

11. Along Del Rosario Street starting from Lecaros Street to College Avenue
12. Along Magallanes Street starting from Lecaros Street to Legazpi Street
13. Along Caritan Highway starting from College Avenue to corner Diversion Road
14. Along College Avenue starting from corner Rizal Street to corner Mabini Street
15. Along Washington Street starting Rizal Street to Mabini Street
16. Along Gonzaga Street starting from Macapagal Avenue to Mabini Street
17. Along Arellano Street starting from Rizal Street to Mabini Street
18. Along Legazpi Street starting Extension College Avenue to Rizal Street
19. Along Gomez Street starting Mabini Street to Macapagal Avenue
20. Along Aguinaldo Street starting Mabini Street to Rizal Street
21. Along Zamora Street starting Mabini Street to Rizal Street
22. Along Don Domingo starting Balzain Road to corner Macapagal Avenue

SECTION 4. TWO-WAY STREETS. Two-Way Traffic shall be maintained at the following streets:

1. Along Bonifacio Street (from Lecaros Street to Circumferential Road)
2. Along Macapagal Road (from Don Domingo to corner Gonzaga Street)
3. Along Circumferential Road (from Cataggaman Road to Avocado Street)
4. Along Luna Street (from (corner Rizal Street to Buntun)
5. Along Lecaros Street (from corner Rizal Street to Maribbay Street)
6. Along Balzain Road (from College Avenue to Junction Tanza)
7. Diversion Road (from Junction Tanza to Buntun)

SECTION 5. NO PARKING

1. Strictly NO PARKING along Del Rosario Street from corner Luna Street to corner College Avenue
2. NO PARKING along Gonzaga Street from corner Bonifacio Street to corner Del Rosario Street
3. NO PARKING along Burgos Street from corner Gonzaga Street to corner Legazpi Street and Gonzaga Street and from corner Gomez Street to corner Luna Street
4. NO PARKING on both sides in front of Saint Paul University (Mabini Street)
5. NO PARKING along Mabini Street from corner Arellano Street to corner Lecaros Street (USL)
6. NO PARKING along Rizal Street from Arellano Street to Aguinaldo Street (in front of East Central School)
7. NO PARKING along College Avenue
8. NO PARKING along Luna Street from corner Rizal Street to Magallanes Street
9. NO PARKING along Magallanes Street from corner Luna Street to corner Legazpi Street
10. NO PARKING along Aguinaldo Street from corner Blumentritt Street to Valenzuela Street
11. NO PARKING along Legazpi Street from corner Taft Street to corner Burgos Street
12. NO PARKING along Arellano Street from corner Burgos Street to corner Del Rosario Street
13. NO PARKING along Methodist Christian School from 12:30 P.M. to 1:30 P.M. up to Gonzaga from corner Bonifacio Street to corner Del Rosario Street
14. Along Del Rosario Street, STRICTLY NO PARKING from corner Luna Street to College Avenue
15. NO PARKING along Bonifacio Street from Gonzaga Street to Gomez Street and Balzain Road from 11:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. and 4:00 P.M to 7:00 P.M.
16. Parking is allowed along Bonifacio Street and Balzain Road from 8:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. and 1:00 P.M. to 4:00 P.M.

SECTION 6. PARKING SPACE. Parking space shall be maintained at the following streets namely:

1. Right side parking along Mabini Street starting from corner Washington Street to corner Arellano Street.
2. Right side parking along Blumentritt Street from corner Aguinaldo Street to corner Washington Street.
3. Right side parking along Rizal Street from corner Aguinaldo Street to corner Legazpi Street.
4. Right side parking along Legazpi Street from corner Magallanes Street to corner Taft Street and from corner Burgos Street to corner Bonifacio Street.
5. Right side parking along Taft Street from corner Legazpi Street to corner Arellano Street.
6. Right side parking along Arellano Street from corner Bonifacio Street to corner Burgos Street and from corner Del Rosario Street to corner Mabini Street.

7. Right side parking only for Bonifacio Street.
8. Right side parking only along Blumentritt Street and Arellano Street from corner Bonifacio Street up to Burgos Street.

SECTION 7. LOADING AND UNLOADING

1. There shall be a designated loading and unloading zones/bays at every thirty (30) meters away from corner along the right side of Bonifacio Street. The use of these designated loading and unloading zones/bays shall be limited to a maximum period of ten (10) minutes.
2. There shall be loading and unloading zone along Balzain Road at the right side ten (10) meters before the entrance of University of Cagayan Valley and left side of the road in front of NOVO and five (5) meters before parking entrance of Unitop.
3. There shall be loading and unloading zone along the right side of Bagay Road particularly in between the main entrance and gate 2 of Cagayan National High School and on the left side of Bagay Road particularly in front of Cagayan State University-Andrews Campus and left side of the road beside Public Library.
4. There shall be loading and unloading zone at the left side along Del Rosario Street in front of Methodist Christian School.
5. There shall be loading and unloading zone along Mabini Street at the corner Arellano particularly in front of LACE Building and in front of University of Saint Louis five (5) meters away from the main entrance of the high school department.
6. Delivery vehicles with a gross weight of less than four thousand and five hundred (4,500) kilograms of the business establishments located along Bonifacio Street are allowed to load and unload their goods/merchandise from 8:00 P.M. to 7:30 A.M.
7. Loading and Unloading stations shall be established.
8. The piling up of parking vehicles in Balzain shall be regulated.

SECTION 8. PEDESTRIAN LANE. Pedestrian lanes shall be established at every corner of the streets along Bonifacio Street, churches, school zones, in front of Big Malls and along the whole stretch of Balzain.

SECTION 9. INTERSECTIONS. All intersections/crossings shall be maintained as open to avoid clogging of vehicles and thus facilitate the proper and orderly management of traffic flow. In doing so, all intersections/crossing shall be marked with yellow cross lines.

SECTION 10. TRUCK AND VEHICLE BAN.

1. No entry for all heavy vehicles with gross weight of 4,500 kilograms and above in all streets within the Poblacion from 7 o'clock and 4 o'clock in the afternoon to 7 o'clock in the evening
2. No entry for all vehicles with gross weight of 4,500 kilograms within the school zone from 11 o'clock in the morning to 1 o'clock in the afternoon
 - a. College Avenue (University of Cagayan Valley Main)
 - b. Mabini Street (St. Paul University and University of Saint Louis)
 - c. Linao Road (Tuguegarao North Central School)
 - d. Bagay Road (Cagayan National High School and Cagayan State University Andrews Campus)
 - e. Bonifacio Street (Methodist Christian School)
 - f. Rizal Street (Tuguegarao East Central School)
 - g. Luna Street (Tuguegarao West Central School)
3. Vehicles and other heavy equipment used in government projects including fire trucks and ambulances are exempted from the Truck/Vehicle Ban

SECTION 11. SIGNAGES.

1. No establishment, private or public, shall allot any portion of the road or the shoulder thereof as its exclusive parking space.
2. Placards and signages improperly installed or situated particularly those that adversely affect or cause obstruction to the smooth flow of traffic shall be removed and confiscated by authorities.
3. The City Engineering Office shall prepare presentable, durable and visible signages which will be charged against the traffic funds under the Office of the City Mayor.

4. Signages will be placed in strategic places and traffic enforcers will be deployed to familiarize, guide and direct the traffic.
5. All traffic signages, including ONE WAY/TWO WAY as well as traffic advisories to be in place before November 1, 2016.
6. Printing of tarpaulins informing the public of the Experimental Traffic Scheme to start on November 1, 2016 ready for posting on October 15, 2016.

SECTION 12. NO ENTRY.

1. No entry in Centro 1 to 12 for all public utility vehicles (PUBs, PUVs and PUJs).
2. No entry for all vehicles as would counter flow the directions of designated one way streets within the Poblacion. For purposes of the Ordinance, Poblacion shall refer to Barangays covering Centro 1 to Centro 12 including Ugac Sur, Ugac Norte, part of Caritan Centro and San Gabriel, except on barangays and areas located along diversion road from Balzain Junction to Buntun Highway.
3. NO ENTRY in Pinacauan Bridge for Passengers Buses and Heavy Equipment vehicles.
4. No entry in Macapagal Avenue for Passengers Buses and Heavy Equipment vehicles having a gross weight of 4,500 and above.
5. No left turn from Bonifacio Street to Luna Street going to Saints Peter and Paul Cathedral.

SECTION 13. IMPLEMENTATION.

The Public Order and Safety Unit (POSU), Philippine National Police and the Traffic Enforcers are hereby mandated to implement in full force and authority the provisions of this Ordinance. A public hearing shall be conducted after the implementation of the Experimental Traffic Scheme to consider its effectiveness and/or adaptation before the enactment of a new ordinance adopting the new traffic scheme.

The implementation of this ordinance shall be phase by phase, from Centro 01 to 10 with the inclusion of Caritan Centro up to Bagay Road for the first thirty (30) days except Balzain. After the 30-day period, Centro 11 and Centro 12 shall be included, with no parking allowed from 11:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. and 4:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.

SECTION 14. ENFORCEMENT

1. The Traffic Enforcers shall be under the operational control of the Public order and Safety Unit of Tuguegarao City.
2. The Driver's License of the motorist found to have violated this ordinance shall be confiscated.
3. The driver whose license has been confiscated shall be issued with corresponding Traffic Violation Citation Ticket.
4. The Traffic Violation Citation Ticket shall be the basis of the Treasurer's Office of the City Government to receive the payment of fine.
5. No Driver's License shall be released without presenting the receipt of payment of fine and proof of compliance with the other penalties.
6. Violators shall be given three (3) days to redeem their confiscated driver's license from the Tuguegarao City Police Station.
7. All unclaimed driver's license after three (3) days shall be officially communicated by the Chief of Police to the Land Transportation Office for appropriate action.

SECTION 15. PENALTIES. Any persons violating this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

15.1 First Offense – Fine of Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00) and confiscation of driver's license;

15.2 Second Offense – Fine of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00), confiscation of driver's license and one hour orientation seminar.

15.3 Third and Succeeding Offenses – Fine of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00), confiscation of driver's license and one hour orientation seminar.

SECTION 16. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Any provision or part hereof declared null and void by any competent authority shall not affect the other provisions of this Ordinance.


SECTION 17. REPEALING CLAUSE. Ordinances and other local legislations inconsistent with this Ordinance or parts thereof are hereby modified or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 18. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance will be valid for sixty (60) days starting on November 01, 2016 to December 31, 2016.


