RESOLUTION ACCREDITING CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS BASED IN TUGUEGARAO CITY PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 64 OF THE IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE AND DILG MC NO. 2016-97

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Memorandum Circular (MC) 2016-97 - Accreditation of Civil Society Organizations, and Selection of Representatives to the Local Special Bodies dated July 19, 2016;

WHEREAS, the said Memorandum Circular reiterates the provisions of the Local Government Code relative to the accreditation of civil society organizations, and in the selection of representatives to the local special bodies to strengthen their participation in local governance and development processes;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tuguegarao City recognizes the vital role of Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) which include non-state and non-profit associations, non-governmental organizations, people's organizations, civil organizations, cooperatives, social movements, and professional and business groups in nation building and their collective efforts towards progress;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tuguegarao City further recognizes the role of the CSOs as partners of the Tuguegarao City Government not only in policy and planning formulation but more so in development implementation;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tuguegarao City through the Committee on Rules, Laws and Ethics has reviewed and approved the applications for accreditation of the following Civil Society Organizations:

- 2. Barangay Nutrition Scholars of Tuguegarao City (Board Resolution, Annual Accomplishment Report, Financial Statement and Certificate of Registration)
- 3. Pinag-Isang Tanod ng Cagayan (PITACA) (Minutes of the Meeting, Annual Accomplishment Report and Financial Statement)
- 4. Police Herline Movement, Inc. (Certificate of Registration, List of Officers, Annual Accomplishment Report, Financial Statement, Profile and Minutes of the Meeting)

WHEREAS, the accreditation shall be valid for three (3) years commencing on August 30, 2016 up to June 2019;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tuguegarao City reserves the right to revoke and/or cancel the accreditation in the event that they fail to comply with their undertakings or for any violation of existing laws, rules and regulations.

NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED as it is hereby RESOLVED, to accredit the nineteen (19) Civil Society Organizations based in Tuguegarao City pursuant to Article 64 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Local Government Code and DILG MC 2016-97 to entitle them with the prerogatives and privileges stated therein.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this Resolution be given to the accredited organizations for their information.
