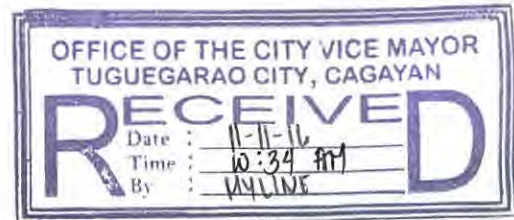



SUBJECT:

CY 2016 SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM OF TUGUEGARAO CITY, CAGAYAN

FINDINGS/OBSERVATIONS:

As a matter of procedure, the Provincial Planning and Development Office (PPDO) submits its findings and comments on the Annual Investment Program/Plan(AIP) duly approved by the different lower Sanggunian (Sangguniang Bayan in the different municipalities, and Sangguniang Panlungsod in the City of Tuguegarao) of the Province of Cagayan.
