**CITY RESOLUTION NO. 227-B-2016**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AND APPROVING CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (CDRRMC) RESOLUTION NO. 05-2016 TITLED “RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REALIGNMENT OF FUNDS FROM THE THEMATIC AREAS OF THE 2016 LDRRMF AS FOLLOWS: A.) PREVENTION AND MITIGATION B.) PREPAREDNESS C.) REHABILITATION AND RECOVERY TO A.) REPAIR/REHABILITATION OF GOVERNMENT INFRASTRUCTURE, FACILITIES AND STREETLIGHTS AND B.) EMERGENCY CALAMITY ASSISTANCE TO ADDRESS THE DAMAGES CAUSED BY SUPER TYPHOON LAWIN IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P3,600,000.00)”**

**WHEREAS**, the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (CDRRMC) has passed CDRRMC Resolution No. 05-2016 titled “*Resolution Approving the Realignment of Funds from the Thematic Areas of the 2016 LDRRMF as follows: A.) Prevention and Mitigation B.) Preparedness C.) Rehabilitation and Recovery to a.) Repair/Rehabilitation of Government Infrastructure, Facilities and Streetlights” and b.) “Emergency/Calamity Assistance” to Address the Damages Caused by Super Typhoon Lawin in the Total Amount of Three Million Six Hundred Thousand Pesos (P3,600,000.00);*”

**WHEREAS**, the City Mayor, Hon. Atty. Jefferson P. Soriano, has endorsed the said Resolution to the Seventh City Council for adoption and approval;

**WHEREAS**, there is an immediate need to realign the unutilized seventy percent (70%) of the LDRRMF of CY 2016 as too enable the city government to undertake important services and activities thus enhance its capability in dealing with the impacts of Super Typhoon Lawin and to allocate funds for the programs, projects and activities relative thereto;

**WHEREAS**, the disbursements of funds shall be subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

"REPAIR/REHABILITATION OF GOVERNMENT INFRASTRUCTURE, FACILITIES & STREETLIGHTS" & B.) "EMERGENCY/CALAMITY ASSISTANCE" TO ADDRESS THE DAMAGES CAUSED BY SUPER TYPHOON "LAWIN" IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (Php 3,600,000.00)**

**WHEREAS**, Tuguegarao City has experienced the onslaught of Super Typhoon Lawin (International code name Haima) classified as Category 5 that hit Tuguegarao City which brought widespread devastations and disastrous effects on the lives and properties of the people in the City;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Unit is enjoined to observe optimum, efficient and judicious use of funds, facilities and other resources to ensure that plans and objectives in relation to disaster management are implemented, achieved and more importantly responsive to demands of the present situation and needs of the people particularly relief assistance and rehabilitation of the damaged properties and facilities;

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides among others that a supplemental budget may also be enacted in times of public calamity by way of budgetary realignment to set aside appropriations for the purchase of supplies and materials or the payment of services which are exceptionally urgent or absolutely indispensable to prevent imminent danger to, or loss of, life or property, in the jurisdiction of the local government unit;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to realign the unutilized seventy percent (70%) of the LDRRMF of CY 2016 as to enable the city government to undertake important services and activities thus enhance its capability in dealing with the impacts of Super Typhoon "LAWIN" and to allocate funds for the programs, projects and activities relative thereto to wit;

REHABILITATION & RECOVERY – P1,000,000.00 TO A.) “REPAIR/REHABILITATION OF GOVERNMENT INFRASTRUCTURE, FACILITIES & STREETLIGHTS” AMOUNTING TO Php 2,600,000.00, & B.) “EMERGENCY/CALAMITY ASSISTANCE” AMOUNTING TO Php 1,000,000.00 TO ADDRESS THE DAMAGES CAUSED BY SUPER TYPHOON “LAWIN”**
