RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) AMONG THE BUREAU OF FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCES (BFAR) REGION 02, THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF TUGUEGARAO AND MR. ORLANDO MACANANG FOR THE TECHNOLOGY DEMONSTRATION CUM LIVELIHOOD PROJECT OF TILAPIA IN SEMI-INTENSIVE POND AND GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR, HON. BIENVENIDO C. DE GUZMAN II, TO SIGN FOR THE SAID MOA FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, one of the essential objectives of the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) is to increase fish farmers' production and profitability;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to develop and manage available fishery resources to provide fisherfolk with livelihood and source of income;
