**WHEREAS**, the Annual Investment Program (AIP) is an investment programming document based on the Local Development Investment Plan (LDIP) and is operationalized by the budget;

**WHEREAS**, CDC Resolution No. 14, Series of 2017: Resolution endorsing to the 7<sup>th</sup> Tuguegarao City Council the approval of the Tuguegarao City CY 2018 Annual Investment Program was endorsed to the Seventh City Council for appropriate action.



On motion of Hon. Danilo L. Baccay and without any objection, **CITY RESOLUTION NO. 317-2017** was **APPROVED** under suspended rules.


