**WHEREAS**, last October 19, 2016, Tuguegarao City suffered the onslaught of Super Typhoon Lawin, the first ever typhoon to reach the status of Signal No. 5 in the history of the Philippines;

**WHEREAS**, Super Typhoon Lawin brought unimaginable damage to the government, household and business properties of the people as well as to the agricultural land preparations and crops incurring a total of P1,704,600,000.00 damage on infrastructure and P14, 754,944.00 on agriculture;

**WHEREAS**, through the grace of the Almighty and the disaster risk reduction management of Tuguegarao City and its people particularly on the thematic areas of disaster preparedness and disaster response, the city recorded zero casualty: no lives lost after the wrath of the super typhoon;

**WHEREAS**, the onslaught of mega-disasters such as Super Typhoon Lawin calls for a more resilient community through the continuous cooperation and collaboration of the government and the people highlighting the role of all stakeholders in taking urgent collective action in building grassroots resilience with the effects of climate change already a reality;

**WHEREAS**, to commemorate the survival of Tuguegarao City during the Super Typhoon Lawin and to serve a reminder to the people of Tuguegarao to maintain the character and practice of disaster resilience at all times, the Sanggunian recognizes the benefits of declaring the Month of October as the Disaster prevention and Preparedness Month in Tuguegarao City;


**RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to declare the Month of October as the Disaster Prevention and Preparedness Month in Tuguegarao City.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, to mandate all government instrumentalities and private institutions and establishments in Tuguegarao City to conduct disaster prevention and preparedness related activities in October of every year.
