CITY ORDINANCE NO. 12-2018

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RENTAL RATES OF THE STALLS IN THE NEWLY
 CONSTRUCTED CANTEEN AT THE CITY HALL COMPLEX**

WHEREAS, Section 10(D)(2)(e) of Republic Act No. 8755, otherwise known as the “Tuguegarao City Charter”, provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall appropriate funds for the construction and maintenance or the rental buildings for the use of the City, and upon the majority of all members, the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall authorize the City Mayor to lease to private parties such public buildings held in a propriety capacity, subject to the existing laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the newly constructed canteen at the back of the city hall is for the relocation of the existing locators/vendors in front of the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) and Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) to comply with the requirements of the Commission on Audit (COA) to regulate their operation in order to provide them a more convenient place to sell their goods for a more orderly operation in the premises;

WHEREAS, the Seventh City Council finds it proper to enact “An Ordinance Prescribing the Rates of the Stalls in the Newly Constructed Canteen at the City Hall Complex;”

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** by the Seventh City Council in session assembled, to enact the following:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as “*AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE RATES OF THE STALLS IN THE NEWLY CONSTRUCTED CANTEEN AT THE CITY HALL COMPLEX.*”

SECTION 2. RENTAL RATES. The monthly rental rate shall be fixed as follows:

- a. For Fixed Table Corner – Php5.00/square meter/day
- b. For Open Space – Php3.00/square meter/day

Due to limited space, fruits, xerox machines, office supplies and notary public stands should temporarily stay in front of the DFA Office beside the Pasalubong Center, until such time that additional stalls shall have been constructed as an annex to the newly constructed City Hall Canteen.

SECTION 3. ELECTRICITY AND OTHER UTILITIES.

- a. The Lessee shall be responsible for payment of electric bills and other utilities.
- b. Sub-meters shall be installed for locators using electric Alternating Current (CAGELCO/AC) and Direct Current (Generator/DC)

SECTION 4. OPERATION OF THE THREE (3) EXISTING LOCATORS (Xerox Machine)


- 1. The operation of the three existing locators (xerox machine) shall be limited to only one (1) xerox machine each. In case the xerox machine is no longer operational, a replacement thereof is allowed. The City General Services Office shall be authorized to confiscate xerox machines being operated in violation of this provision. Should the existing locators wish to make use of additional xerox machines in the future, there should be a written request addressed to the City Council in order for the necessary amendment in this Ordinance to be made.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
