CITY ORDINANCE NO. 36-2018

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE TUGUEGARAO CITY BLOOD COUNCIL AND THE 49 BARANGAY BLOOD COUNCILS TO ESTABLISH A VOLUNTARY BLOOD DONATION PROGRAM AND PRESCRIBING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ITS EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATION IN THE CITY OF TUGUEGARAO

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that "the State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;"

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that "Local Government Units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety;"



WHEREAS, among the policies enunciated under Republic Act No. 7719, otherwise known as the National Blood Services Act of 1994, and Administrative Order No. 210-002 dated January 07, 2010 is the promotion and encouragement of voluntary blood donation by the citizenry;

WHEREAS, the same law was enacted to instill public consciousness of the principle that blood donation is a humanitarian act;

WHEREAS, there is a need to plan and implement a local blood donation program which would promote voluntary blood donation and provide an adequate supply of safe blood to effectively respond to the needs of the constituents during ordinary and critical times.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tuguegarao City in session assembled:

ARTICLE I TITLE

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Creating the Tuguegarao City Blood Council and the 49 Barangay Councils."

ARTICLE II CREATION OF THE CITY AND BARANGAY BLOOD COUNCILS

SECTION 2. CREATION OF A LOCAL BLOOD COUNCIL AND THE 49 BARANGAY BLOOD COUNCILS. The City Blood Council to be known as "The Tuguegarao City Blood Council" and the 49 Barangay Blood Councils are hereby created to institutionalize the provisions of Republic Act 7719, otherwise known as the National Blood Services Act of 1994.

ARTICLE III TUGUEGARAO CITY BLOOD COUNCIL

SECTION 3. COMPOSITION OF THE TUGUEGARAO CITY BLOOD COUNCIL. The Tuguegarao City Blood Council shall be composed of the following members:

Chairman : City Mayor
Vice Chairman : City Vice Mayor
Members : City Health Officer

Chief of Hospital of the Tuguegarao City People's General Hospital

Chairman of the Committee on Health President of the Liga ng mga Barangay

Other CSOs

NGOs such as Medical Associations, groups or organizations such as



Representatives from the Cagayan Valley Medical Center, Philippine National Red Cross, Philippine National Police, School Heads or

SECTION 4. FUNCTIONS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE TUGUEGARAO CITY BLOOD COUNCIL. The Tuguegarao City Blood Council shall have the following functions, duties and responsibilities:

- a. To formulate the City's Voluntary Blood Donation Program Strategic Plan;
- To supervise the Barangay Blood Councils in coordination with the Liga ng mga Barangay President;
- c. To monitor and evaluate the Blood Donation Program;
- Incorporate into the strategic plans and programs such as education, medical services, blood donor recruitment, retention/care and blood typing;
- e. Identify and train Barangay Coordinators who shall make operational the barangay blood council;
- f. Generate multi-sectoral support for the City and Barangay Blood Donation Program;
- g. Organize a City-wide Blood Donation Activity at least two (2) times a year;
- h. Maintain a master list of the voluntary blood donors in the city; and,



i. Conduct meetings, trainings, seminars and orientation on Blood Donation Program.

ARTICLE IV BARANGAY BLOOD COUNCIL

SECTION 5. COMPOSITION OF THE BARANGAY BLOOD COUNCIL. The Barangay Chairman shall act as the Chairman of the Barangay Blood Council and may appoint a Blood Coordinator who shall serve as the Vice Chairman. The members shall include two (2) barangay kagawads designated by the Barangay Chairman, the barangay health worker and the barangay nurse or midwife, if applicable.

SECTION 6. FUNCTIONS OF THE BARANGAY BLOOD COUNCIL – The Barangay Blood Council shall have the following functions:

- a. Prepare for the conduct of regular blood activities of the barangay;
- Conduct barangay level information and education campaigns on barangay blood donation and also to civic organizations, schools and all stakeholders and sectors in the community;
- Ensure that every barangay should have at least ten (10) donors for every 1,000 population or 1%
 of the total population of the barangay and 2% recruits and available donors;
- d. Maintain and update a master list of the voluntary blood donors in the barangay; and,
- Refer clients to the City Health Office to facilitate referral to blood banks for subsequent release of requested blood.

ARTICLE V FINAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 7. The City Mayor shall, upon approval of this ordinance, issue implementing rules and regulations pursuant to RA 7719, Administrative Order No. 210-002 and other issuances.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in force and effect.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, local issuances or rules inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and after compliance with the publication requirements.
