**CITY RESOLUTION NO. 189-2018**

**A RESOLUTION URGING THE INCUMBENT CITY MAYOR TO DESIGNATE A FULL-TIME COMMUNITY TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT COORDINATOR (CTEC) FOR TUGUEGARAO CITY**

**WHEREAS**, in line with its priority on poverty alleviation, the government aims to have a more responsive community-based education and training programs in the grassroots or local level;

**WHEREAS**, in order to attain the above objective, there is a need for Local Government Units (LGUs) to designate a Community Training and Employment Coordinators (CTEC) as focal persons in the delivery of community-based trainings and employment services with the end goal of an effective implementation and management of the same;

**WHEREAS**, the City Mayor has endorsed to the Seventh City Council the letter of the Provincial Director of the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) requesting for a passage of a resolution encouraging LGUs to designate a full-time Community Training and Employment Coordinator (CTEC) for their respective municipalities/cities;

**WHEREAS**, after a discussion and deliberation on the matter during the committee level meeting and the 89<sup>th</sup> Regular Session of the Seventh City Council, both the committee concerned and the Council deemed it proper, necessary and beneficial to approve the herein request;


**WHEREAS**, the said Community Training and Employment Coordinators (CTEC) shall come from the Public Employment Service Office (PESO) as the Permanent-Designate representative and from the Technology Livelihood and Development Office as the alternative-designate because of the nature of work and services they offer.

**NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to urge the Incumbent City Mayor to designate a full-time Community Training and Employment Coordinator (CTEC) for Tuguegarao City.


