CITY RESOLUTION NO. 189-2018

A RESOLUTION URGING THE INCUMBENT CITY MAYOR TO DESIGNATE A FULL-TIME COMMUNITY TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT COORDINATOR (CTEC) FOR TUGUEGARAO CITY

WHEREAS, in line with its priority on poverty alleviation, the government aims to have a more responsive community-based education and training programs in the grassroots or local level;

WHEREAS, in order to attain the above objective, there is a need for Local Government Units (LGUs) to designate a Community Training and Employment Coordinators (CTEC) as focal persons in the delivery of community-based trainings and employment services with the end goal of an effective implementation and management of the same;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor has endorsed to the Seventh City Council the letter of the Provincial Director of the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) requesting for a passage of a resolution encouraging LGUs to designate a full-time Community Training and Employment Coordinator (CTEC) for their respective municipalities/cities;

WHEREAS, after a discussion and deliberation on the matter during the committee level meeting and the 89th Regular Session of the Seventh City Council, both the committee concerned and the Council deemed it proper, necessary and beneficial to approve the herein request;

WHEREAS, the said Community Training and Employment Coordinators (CTEC) shall come from the Public Employment Service Office (PESO) as the Permanent-Designate representative and from the Technology Livelihood and Development Office as the alternative-designate because of the nature of work and services they offer.
