#### **CITY RESOLUTION NO. 204-2018**

RESOLUTION AMENDING CITY RESOLUTION NO. 195-2018 TITLED "RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACTING CITY MAYOR, HON. BIENVENIDO C. DE GUZMAN II, TO TRANSACT, NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE BEST TERMS AND CONDITIONS WITH LEGITIMATE AND QUALIFIED OPERATORS AND BUSINESSMEN FROM TUGUEGARAO CITY FOR THE 2018 "PRESYO AGAWID"/BARATILYO SUBJECT TO THE RATIFICATION OF THE SEVENTH CITY COUNCIL AND EXISTING APPLICABLE LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS"

WHEREAS, a tradition and part of the celebration of the 294<sup>th</sup> Patronal Feast of Tuguegarao is the "Presyo Agawid"/ Baratilyo which is usually held at the portions of some streets of Tuguegarao City;

WHEREAS, the Seventh City Council approved City Resolution No. 195-2018 titled "Resolution Authorizing the Acting City Mayor, Hon. Bienvenido C. De Guzman II, to Transact, Negotiate and Enter into a Contract with the Best Terms and Conditions with Legitimate and Qualified Operators and Businessmen from Tuguegarao City for the 2018 "Presyo Agawid" / Baratilyo Subject to the Ratification of the Seventh City Council and Existing Applicable Laws, Rules and Regulations" during its 91st Regular Session held on July 10, 2018;

WHEREAS, there is a need to change the name from Hon. Bienvenido C. De Guzman II to Hon. Atty. Jefferson P. Soriano because of the transition in the administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVE, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to grant authority to the City Mayor, Hon. Atty. Jefferson P. Soriano, pursuant to the pertinent provisions of Section 22 of the Local Government Code to transact, negotiate and enter into a contract with the best terms and conditions with legitimate and qualified operators and businessmen from Tuguegarao City, subject to the ratification of the Seventh City Council, on the following conditions:



For the operator:

- To commence the "Presyo Agawid"/ Baratilyo 2018 on July 31, 2018, 12:00 midnight and end on September 15, 2018, 12:00 midnight
- 2. To secure a Mayor's Permit;
- 3. To install and dismantle the stalls;
- 4. To pay the electric and water bills;
- 5. To maintain the cleanliness and sanitation within the premises;
- 6. To hire additional sweepers to augment the number of present sweepers;
- 7. To secure and ensure the safety of their goods and personnel;
- 8. Not to use flammable materials such as LPG and firewood;
- 9. Not to extend the time and days of operation;
- To post a security/surety bond in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Pesos (P100,000.00) to guarantee the performance of the operator's obligations and to answer for whatever damages incurred in the operation of the business;
- To provide six (6) pieces ten-pounder fire extinguishers and coordinate with the fire marshal for the locations; and,
- 12. To pay the corresponding penalty for violations, as provided by laws.

For the Tuguegarao City Government:


- 1. To itemize all fees paid by the operator;
- 2. To re-route the flow of traffic to ensure orderliness;
- 3. To make sure that a fire truck shall always be available at the vicinity;
- 4. To provide relocation sites for street vendors;
- 5. To provide parking spaces for tricycles;
- 6. To insure public safety, peace and order in the vicinity;
- 7. To ensure police visibility and augment the number of traffic aides;
- 8. To provide a scheme in garbage collection;
- 9. To furnish the City Council a copy of the contracts or offers pertinent to this authority;
- To submit a full report on the implementation of the terms and conditions provided in the instant ordinance two (2) weeks after the period of "Presyo Agawid"/Baratilyo 2018; and,
- 11. To put up an Information Center in the Office of the Market Administrator, with all the members of the Task Group.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the amount of the contract price shall not be lower than One Million Seven Hundred Thousand Pesos (P1,700,000.00) floor price, with a thirty percent (30%) down payment upon execution of the contract and the balance shall be paid on or before September 10, 2018, however, if there is no taker, the City Mayor may negotiate for the best terms but not lower than One Million Seven Hundred Thousand Pesos (P1,700,000.00) and, if there is no taker, the amount of One Million Seven Hundred Thousand Pesos (P1,700,000.00) shall be divided among the interested locators.

On motion of Hon. Raymund P. Guzman, duly seconded by Hon. Winnoco R. Abraham and with the abstention of Hon. Maila Rosario T. Que, CITY RESOLUTION NO. 204-2018 was APPROVED under suspended rules.
