CITY RESOLUTION NO. 233-2018

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COMMISSION ON ELECTIONS (COMELEC) EN BANC TO EXTEND THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS IN TUGUEGARAO CITY FOR A PERIOD OF FIFTEEN (15) WORKING DAYS DUE TO POWER OUTAGE, HEAVY DAMAGE TO AGRICULTURAL CROPS AND UNSTEADY NETWORK SIGNALS CAUSED BY TYPHOON OMPONG

WHEREAS, Tuguegarao City was hit by typhoon Ompong on September 15, 2018;

WHEREAS, as a result of the said typhoon, Tuguegarao City has experienced power outage for almost a week, heavy damage to agricultural crops and unsteady network signals;

WHEREAS, the power outage and unsteady network signals somehow affected the dissemination of information as regards the last day of registration of voters with the COMELEC which was on September 29, 2018;

WHEREAS, due to heavy and severe damage on agricultural crops, would be voter registrants prioritized the forced unscheduled harvest of agricultural crops causing their inability to register as such;

WHEREAS, considering the above circumstances and the devastation caused by typhoon Ompong, there is a need to extend the registration of voters for a period of fifteen (15) working days to give ample time to the residents of Tuguegarao City to register.

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVE, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to request the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) en banc to extend the registration of voters in Tuguegarao City for a period of fifteen (15) working days due to power outage, heavy damage to agricultural crops and unsteady network signals caused by typhoon Ompong.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish copies of this Resolution to Atty. Jims Dandy G. Ramos, Election Officer, Tuguegarao City and Atty. Ederlino U. Tabilas, Regional Election Director, COMELEC RO2, for information and appropriate action.


On joint motion and with the abstention of Hon. Maila Rosario T. Que who asked permission to leave early, **CITY RESOLUTION NO. 233-2018** was **APPROVED** under suspended rules.
