CITY ORDINANCE NO. 040-08-2019

**CITY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE FROM
 VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FOR THE CONDUCT OF NIGHT MARKET OF PORTIONS OF
 GOMEZ STREET (CORNER BONIFACIO TO CORNER TAFT STREET) FOR A PERIOD
 OF SIX (6) MONTHS FROM OCTOBER 15, 2019 TO APRIL 15, 2020
 FROM 6:00 P.M. TO 1:00 A.M.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the pertinent provisions of Section 21 (a) (c) and (d) of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, it is permissible that a city, municipality or barangay, through an ordinance, may temporarily close or regulate the use of any local street, road, thoroughfare or any other public places where flea or night market may be established and where goods, merchandise, foodstuffs, commodities or articles of commerce may be sold and dispensed to the general public;

WHEREAS, due to loss of income as a result of the road clearing operations, street vendors were clamoring for the conduct of Night Market while waiting for the completion of the New Tuguegarao City Public Market (Don Domingo);

WHEREAS, the Eighth City Council has approved City Ordinance No. 039-08-2019 titled “*An Ordinance Authorizing the Conduct of Night Market on an Experimental Basis along Gomez Street (Corner Bonifacio to Corner Taft Street) for a Period of Six (6) Months from October 15, 2019 to April 15, 2020 from 6:00 P.M. to 1:00 A.M.*”;

WHEREAS, the closure of portions of Gomez Street (Corner Bonifacio to Corner Taft Street) shall commence on October 15, 2019 and shall end on April 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, there is a necessity of withholding from vehicular traffic the said streets for purposes of the Night Market for the entire period of October 15, 2019 to April 15, 2020 in accordance with the provisions of Section 21 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160).



NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** by the Eighth City Council in session assembled to enact the following ordinance:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as “*City Ordinance Authorizing the Temporary Closure from Vehicular Traffic for the Conduct of Night Market of Portions of Gomez Street (Corner Bonifacio to Corner Taft Street) for a Period of Six (6) Months from October 15, 2019 to April 15, 2020 from 6:00 P.M. to 1:00 A.M.*.”

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND LIMITATION. This Ordinance shall cover certain portions of Gomez Street (Corner Bonifacio to Corner Taft Street), surrounding the Central Public Market which are declared temporarily closed from vehicular traffic from October 15, 2019 to April 15, 2020 from 6:00 P.M. to 1:00 A.M. for the conduct of Night Market.

SECTION 3. INFORMATION. This Ordinance shall be disseminated through all mass media outlets in Tuguegarao City.


SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTATION. The Implementing Agency shall be the Office of the City Chief of Police in coordination with the City General Services Office and Market Supervisors.

The City Chief of Police shall adopt a system of rerouting traffic in the affected streets, provide adequate loading, unloading and parking areas as well as appropriate access and outlets for firefighting trucks and equipment in case of emergency.


SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
