CITY ORDINANCE NO. 06-2019

AN ORDINANCE GIVING TWENTY PERCENT (20%) DISCOUNT ON FOOD PURCHASE TO WORKING STUDENTS IN THE CITY OF TUGUEGARAO SUBJECT TO APPLICABLE LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS ON THE MATTER

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session duly assembled:

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to recognize the role of the youth in nation building;

WHEREAS, the Tuguegarao City believes that education is “the great equilibrium” and in order for the youth to reach their full potential, assistance in acquiring the skills needed through education is a priority;

WHEREAS, there is a big number of students that need to work for themselves to be able to finance their education;

WHEREAS, assistance in any form will help ease the burden that they are experiencing in pursuing their quest for education.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** by the City Council, to enact:


SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as “**WORKING STUDENTS FOOD DISCOUNT ORDINANCE.**”

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For the purpose of this Ordinance, these terms are defined as follows:

- A. Working Students – refer to any bonafide resident of the City who is currently enrolled in any educational institution excluding masters, doctorate degree, law school and concurrently employed in a legitimate establishment or work place regardless of location or place of business.
- B. Food Establishment – refers to any establishment, particularly in the business of serving food, duly registered and authorized to do business within the territorial jurisdiction of Tuguegarao City. This will not include bars and pubs that serve alcoholic beverages exclusively.
- C. Discount – refers to a minimum of twenty percent (20%) discount for total food consumption of the beneficiary.
- D. School Identification Card – refers to the identification card issued by the schools or educational institutions to students who are currently enrolled in their institutions.
- E. Employment/Work Identification Card (ID) – refers to the identification card issued by the employer to working students who are working in their establishments.
- F. Working Student’s Discount Identification Card (ID) – identification card issued by the city through the Tuguegarao City Youth Development Council Office certifying the beneficiaries’ status as working students, to be presented to participating establishments to avail of the discount. Its validity will be for one (1) year from the issuance thereof.

SECTION 3. DISCOUNT PRIVILEGE OF THE WORKING STUDENTS:

- A. A minimum of twenty percent (20%) discount shall be rendered to working students provided that they will present in advance their Working Student’s Discount Identification Card prior to payment.
- B. Only students who are currently enrolled and at the same time employed are entitled to the said discount.
- C. The student should be a child of or a bonafide resident of the city as reflected in their school and employment I.D. or as certified to by the parent’s voter’s registration receipt (VRR).
- D. The Working Student’s Discount Identification Card shall be given to certified working students free of charge by the Tuguegarao City Youth Development Council’s Office upon completion of the following requirements:
 - 1. School Identification Card (I.D.) with validity on the present school year;
 - 2. If Identification Card has no validity date, submission of assessment form within the semestral period is required.
 - 3. Employment/Work Identification Card (I.D.) with validity on the same school year to which the student is currently enrolled;
 - 4. 2pcs. 1x1 colored picture; and,
 - 5. Voter’s ID or VRR of applicant or of Parents Voter’s ID or VRR.
- E. In case of multiple orders, only one (1) meal will be able to avail of the discount.
- F. Discount is not valid in conjunction with any other discounts or promotions given by the participating food establishments.



SECTION 4. PENALTY

A. Establishment/s that violate this Ordinance will be penalized accordingly:

- First Offense - P2,000.00 fine
- Second Offense - P3,000.00 fine
- Third Offense - P5,000.00 fine and suspension of operation for a month
- Fourth Offense - Revocation of Business Permit or License

B. Any individual that will abuse this privilege through deception and falsification shall be penalized accordingly subject to the provisions of the Juvenile Delinquency Law:

- First Offense - P1,000.00 fine
- Second Offense - P2,000.00 fine
- Third Offense - P3,000.00 fine or five (5) days imprisonment

SECTION 5. The Business Permit and License Office together with the Public Employment Service Office and the Tuguegarao City Youth Development Office is hereby tasked to monitor and receive complaints in accordance with the implementation of this Ordinance.


SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any portion or provision of this Ordinance is declared as void or unconstitutional, the remaining portions thereof shall not be affected thereby and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any provision of law or regulation inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed, revoked or modified accordingly.


SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days upon approval.

CORE OF DISCUSSION:

Hon. Raymund P. Guzman, Chair of the Committee on Laws, Ordinances, Revisions and Legal Matters, acknowledged all participants, including all City Officials present and introduced the matter at hand.

Hon. Jude T. Bayona, the principal author, explained and gave an overview regarding the ordinance. He stated that it is the policy of the state to recognize the role of the youth in nation building and that a big number of students in the City work for themselves to finance their education and it is the responsibility of the City Government of Tuguegarao to at least alleviate the burden that these working students have been experiencing in pursuit to education. This is why the Council has sponsored this kind of ordinance. He also manifested that the ordinance is requesting for a 20% discount for food purchase only of working students who are residents and citizens of the City currently enrolled in any educational institution excluding masters and doctorate degrees, law schools and those who are concurrently employed in a legitimate establishment or workplace regardless of location or place of business.

After presenting the provisions of the proposed ordinance, the following questions, clarifications and suggestions were raised:


- In the current situation, all bakeries only give 5% discount on all current discount card holders like Senior Citizens and PWDs instead of 25% for pastries and baked goods, but so as not to complicate the provisions of the draft ordinance at hand, the same 20% discount shall be given to all regardless of the food or products being bought or purchased by the working students.

The Chair adjourned the public hearing at 3:45 PM, there being no more issues to be raised.






