**CITY ORDINANCE NO. 11-2019**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 03-2011, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS  
“AN ORDINANCE UPDATING THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM FOR POOR BUT DESERVING  
STUDENTS OF TUGUEGARAO CITY”**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act No. 10931, otherwise known as the “Universal Access to Quality Tertiary Education,” provides that “All Filipino students enrolled in State Universities and Colleges or Local Universities and Colleges shall be exempt from paying their tuition and other school fees upon enrollment”;

**WHEREAS**, the Tuguegarao City Government has been extending various scholarship programs to students of Tuguegarao City such as the Academic (Acad) Scholarship, the Ibanag Culture and the Arts (ICA) Scholarship and the Tuguegarao Outstanding Achiever (TOA) Scholarship;

**WHEREAS**, by virtue of the enactment of Republic Act No. 10931 and in order to better serve the needs of the students of Tuguegarao City, there is a need to amend the provisions of City Ordinance No.



03-2011, otherwise known as "An Ordinance Updating the Scholarship Program for Poor but Deserving Students of Tuguegarao City."

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it **ORDAINED** by the Seventh City Council in session assembled, to enact the following:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Amending City Ordinance No. 03-2011, Otherwise Known as "An Ordinance Updating the Scholarship Program for Poor but Deserving Students of Tuguegarao City."

**SECTION 2.** Paragraphs a, b and c of Section 4, Chapter III, shall be read as follows:

- a. **ACADEMIC (Acad) SCHOLARSHIP** – The academic scholarship is intended to give educational grant to poor but deserving college students who excel scholastically. The City Government shall award two hundred (200) slots for the said scholarship per school year. Each grantee is entitled to receive Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) per semester.
  1. Educational Assistance – Child/Children of indigent solo parents shall have priority in the grant of scholarships and educational assistance under any of the City's applicable programs or projects, subject to the qualification requirements under existing ordinances, rules and regulations; provided that at least 10% of every batch of incoming scholars shall come from the rank of the children of indigent solo parents.
- b. **IBANAG CULTURE AND THE ARTS (ICA) SCHOLARSHIP** – The ICA Scholarship is intended to give educational grant to poor but deserving students who are gifted with talents in the field of music, dance, performing arts and visual arts, and are committed to the promotion of the Ibanag Culture and the Arts. The City Government shall award twenty (20) slots for the said scholarship per school year. Each grantee is likewise entitled to receive Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) per semester.

Both scholarship grants shall be for four or five-year tertiary course in any College or University within the city. However, if the desired degree or course of the grantee is not offered within Tuguegarao City, the grantee may enroll in any University or College within the Province.

- c. **TUGUEGARAO OUTSTANDING ACHIEVER (TOA) SCHOLARSHIP** – The TOA Scholarship grant is intended for poor but deserving students who exemplify highly exceptional scholastic performance, have graduated as one of the top 10 students of their graduating classes and intend to pursue a degree in any college or university in the Philippines. The City Government shall award three (3) slots for the said scholarship per school year. Under this scholarship program, the City Government shall pay the tuition fee and miscellaneous expenses that will be incurred by the grantee enrolled in PRIVATE COLLEGE/UNIVERSITY. In case the grantee is enrolled in a State University or College (SUC) outside the Province, the amount of FORTY THOUSAND PESOS (P40,000.00) per semester shall be given to the grantee. If the grantee is enrolled in any State University or College (SUC) within the Province, the amount of Twenty-Five Thousand Pesos (P25,000.00) shall be given to the said grantee per semester.

**SECTION 3.** There shall be added a new paragraph in Section 10 to be read as follows:

- a. In case the grade of the grantee taken during the first semester of the grantee's last year in college is not yet available upon the grantee's application for the continuity of his/her scholarship, the said subject shall no longer be included in the computation of the grantee's general weighted average, provided that the grantee has already taken the subject under his/her class.

**SECTION 4. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances or parts thereof that are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed accordingly.

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
