

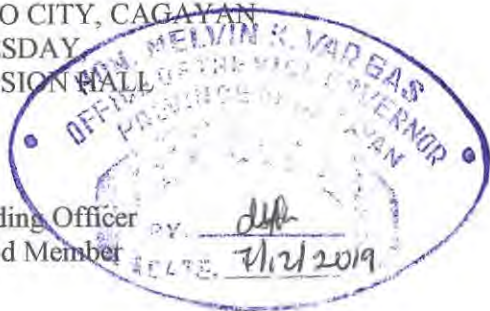

**CITY ORDINANCE NO. 29-2019**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PASSAGE OF TRUCKS AT THE  
INTERSECTION/STREETS BEFORE BUNTUN BRIDGE DURING PEAK HOURS  
ON AN EXPERIMENTAL PERIOD FOR NINETY (90) DAYS  
FROM JULY 15, 2019 TO OCTOBER 15, 2019**

**WHEREAS**, Buntun Bridge is one of the well-known road infrastructures in Region 02 linking the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Districts of Cagayan as well as the Provinces of Isabela, Kalinga and Apayao, and is the gateway of Tuguegarao City to the rest of the Island of Luzon;

**WHEREAS**, Buntun Bridge, a 1.098 km long bridge, was opened sometime in 1969 and is now in service for half a century;

**WHEREAS**, based on the Annual Average Daily Traffic (AADT) survey of the DPWH, Buntun Bridge carries an average of 6,630 vehicles daily;

**WHEREAS**, traffic is congested and is almost at a stand-still at the whole stretch of the bridge during peak hours in the morning (from 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM) and in the afternoon (from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM) because of the volume of vehicles coming in and going out of the city;

**WHEREAS**, in order to ease traffic congestion and prolong the usefulness of the bridge, there is a need to regulate the passage at the bridge during peak hours by prohibiting trucks to pass through during certain hours of the day.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, premises considered, **RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to enact the following Ordinance, viz:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as “*An Ordinance Regulating the Passage of Trucks at the Intersection/Streets Before Buntun Bridge During Peak Hours on an Experimental Period for Ninety (90) Days from July 15, 2019 to October 15, 2019.*”


**SECTION 2.** All cargo, freight and dump trucks with a gross weight of 4.5 tons and above (or from 10-wheels and above) are hereby strictly prohibited from passing through the intersection/streets before Buntun Bridge from 6:00 AM to 9:00 AM and from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM.

**SECTION 3.** Exempted from this prohibition are trucks carrying perishable food items such as fruits, vegetables, fish and dressed chicken, military trucks and equipment, government vehicles and heavy equipment, and vehicles carrying goods for calamity victims during calamity periods.


**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect after ten (10) days of posting of a NOTICE at both ends of the bridge.
