

**CITY ORDINANCE NO. 31-08-2019**

**CITY ORDINANCE DECLARING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE FROM  
 VEHICULAR TRAFFIC OF PORTIONS OF GONZAGA, DEL ROSARIO AND GOMEZ  
 STREETS FROM JULY 30, 2019 TO SEPTEMBER 17, 2019  
 FOR THE TRADITIONAL “PRESYO AGAWID/BARATILYO 2019”**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the pertinent provisions of Section 21 (a) (c) and (d) of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code, the Local Government Unit of Tuguegarao is authorized to temporary close some of the local roads falling within its jurisdiction for the conduct of the traditional “Presyo Agawid/Baratilyo 2019”;

**WHEREAS**, the annual celebration of Tuguegarao City’s Annual Fiesta has been scheduled on August 08-16, 2019 with a week-long socioeconomic-cultural festivities;

**WHEREAS**, among the entrepreneurial activities highlighting the traditional fiesta is the conduct of the “Presyo Agawid/Baratilyo”;

**WHEREAS**, the usual venues for the “Presyo Agawid/Baratilyo” are the streets around the Central Market, namely: Gonzaga, Del Rosario and Gomez Streets;

**WHEREAS**, the “Presyo Agawid/Baratilyo 2019” shall be held on July 30, 2019 to September 17, 2019;

**WHEREAS**, the closure of portions of Gonzaga, Del Rosario and Gomez Streets shall commence on July 30, 2019 and shall end on September 17, 2019;

**WHEREAS**, there is a necessity of withholding from vehicular traffic the said streets for purposes of the “Presyo Agawid/Baratilyo 2019” for the entire period of July 30, 2019 to September 17, 2019 in accordance with the provisions of Section 21 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160).

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it **ORDAINED** by the Eighth City Council in session assembled to enact the following ordinance:

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as “*City Ordinance Declaring the Temporary Closure from Vehicular Traffic of Portions of Gonzaga, Del Rosario and Gomez Streets from July 30, 2019 to September 17, 2019 for the Traditional “Presyo Agawid/Baratilyo 2019.”*”

**SECTION 2. SCOPE AND LIMITATION.** This Ordinance shall cover certain portions of Gonzaga Street Del Rosario Street; and Gomez Street, surrounding the Central Public Market which are declared temporarily closed from vehicular traffic from July 30, 2019 to September 17, 2019 for the conduct of the “Presyo Agawid/Baratilyo 2019” bargain sale of consumer goods and products in connection with the 295<sup>th</sup> Annual Fiesta of Tuguegarao City.

**SECTION 3. INFORMATION.** This Ordinance shall be disseminated through all mass media outlets in Tuguegarao City.


**SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTATION.** The Implementing Agency shall be the Office of the City Chief of Police in coordination with the City General Services Office and Market Supervisors.

The City Chief of Police shall adopt a system of rerouting traffic in the affected streets, provide adequate loading, unloading and parking areas as well as appropriate access and outlets for firefighting trucks and equipment in case of emergency.


**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
