CITY ORDINANCE NO. 17-08-2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 ON PENALTIES OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 14-08-2020 TITLED AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE WEARING OF PROTECTIVE FACE MASK AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that it is the State's policy to protect and promote the right to health of the people;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the *Local Government Code of 1991*, states that "*the Local Government Units are authorized to exercise powers necessary, appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of general welfare;*"

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization has declared Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) as a pandemic and in response thereto, President Rodrigo T. Duterte, through Proclamation No. 922, declared the Philippines under a State of Public Health Emergency;

WHEREAS, a State of Public Health Emergency has been locally declared in Tuguegarao City by virtue of Executive Order No. 15-2020, City Resolution No. 97-08-2020 and CDRRMC Resolution No. 02-2020;

WHEREAS, following the issuance of the Memorandum on March 16, 2020 titled *Community Quarantine over the entire Luzon and further Guidelines for the Management of the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) situation*, Executive Order No. 28 was issued to implement strict home quarantine in all households in Tuguegarao City;

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a highly infectious disease transmitted through droplets between human to human and aside from social distancing, one of the stringent measures to prevent its transmission is the wearing of protective gears primarily face masks;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Hon. Atty. Jefferson P. Soriano, has requested the 8th City Council to enact an ordinance mandating the use of face mask in Tuguegarao City;

WHEREAS, the Eighth City Council during its 36th Regular Session held on April 6, 2020 approved City Ordinance No. 14-08-2020 titled "*An Ordinance Mandating the Use of Face Mask in Tuguegarao City and Providing Penalties for Violations Thereof*;"

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, Hon. Atty. Jefferson P. Soriano, has requested for the amendment of the said ordinance particularly on the penalty for First Offense.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it **ORDAINED** by the Eighth City Council in session duly assembled, to enact:

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as "*An Ordinance Amending City Ordinance No. 14-08-2020 titled An Ordinance Mandating the Use of Face Mask in Tuguegarao City.*"

Section 2. Amendment. Section 5 shall be read as follows:

Section 5. Penalties. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall suffer the penalties provided hereunder:

First Offense	-	Attendance to the 4-hour seminar or Fine of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00)
Second Offense	-	Fine of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00)
Third Offense	-	Fine of Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00)

Implementation of the Seminar. The 4-hour seminar which shall be held after the lifting of the Enhanced Community Quarantine shall be conducted by the PNP and/or City Health Office.


Section 3. Separability Clause. If any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Repealing Clause. All ordinances and administrative regulations or part/s thereof which are inconsistent with any provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.


Section 5. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and shall continue to take effect until the lifting of Enhanced Community Quarantine by proper authorities.
