**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AMENDED MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
 BETWEEN THE TUGUEGARAO CITY GOVERNMENT AND THE CENTER FOR  
 INTERNATIONAL TRADE EXPOSITIONS AND MISSIONS (CITEM)**

**WHEREAS**, the Eighth City Council in its 27<sup>th</sup> Regular Session held on January 21, 2020 adopted Committee Report No. 009-2020 recommending the approval of the Memorandum of Agreement between the Tuguegarao City Government and the Center for International Trade Expositions and Missions;

**WHEREAS**, City Resolution No. 020-08-2020 was likewise passed approving the same and granting authority to the City Mayor, Hon. Atty. Jefferson P. Soriano, to sign for and on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government the said Memorandum of Agreement;

**WHEREAS**, the Ceremonial Signing of the Memorandum of Agreement was conducted on February 4, 2020 at the Sofitel Plaza Hotel;

**WHEREAS**, the Joint Committee on Rules, Laws and Ethics and Committee on Trade and Industry to which the matter was referred, found the Memorandum of Agreement to be in order and with merit and recommended for the amendment below:

*“OTHER PROVISIONS*


*No. 4. In the event that the Corona Virus Disease (COVID-19) will still persist/Exist and/or in case of any fortuitous event or cancellation of the CAEXPO 2020 by the People’s Republic of China, CAEXPO or by the Philippine Government, the City of Tuguegarao will be the priority City of Charm for CAEXPO 2021”.*

**NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVE**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve the amended Memorandum of Agreement between the Tuguegarao City Government and the Center for International Trade Expositions and Missions (CITEM).


On joint motion, **CITY RESOLUTION NO. 098-08-2020** was **APPROVED** under suspended rules.
