CITY RESOLUTION NO. 218-08-2020

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) BETWEEN THE TUGUEGARAO CITY GOVERNMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY (DICT) FOR THE FREE PUBLIC INTERNET ACCESS PROGRAM AND GRANTING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MAYOR, HON. ATTY. JEFFERSON P. SORIANO, TO SIGN FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE TUGUEGARAO CITY GOVERNMENT THE SAID MOA

WHEREAS, the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) is the primary policy, coordinating, implementing and administrative entity of the Executive Branch of the government that plans, develops and promotes the national ICT development agenda;

WHEREAS, the DICT is implementing Republic Act No. 10929, also known as the “Free Internet Access in the Public Places Act”, by undertaking the “Free Public Internet Access Program” across the Philippines to accelerate economic, social and educational opportunities and reduce the Digital Divide under the National Connectivity Program of the Government;

WHEREAS, to promote accessibility to government information and to democratize public services, the LGU intends to avail of the Program by providing wireless internet access within its territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, the DICT and the Tuguegarao City Government agree to collaborate, cooperate, and jointly commit in implementing the Program within the Tuguegarao City Government’s territorial jurisdiction through the shared utilization of their respective resources to effect a positive impact in increasing the reach of internet capacity for the common good;

WHEREAS, the Indorsement of the City Mayor, Hon. Atty. Jefferson P. Soriano, requesting for an authority to sign for and on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government the Memorandum of Agreement

with the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) was referred to the Committee on Health and Sanitation and Committee on Rules, Laws and Ethics;


WHEREAS, upon review of the subject referral, the Joint Committees recommend for the adoption and approval of the MOA and the granting of authority to the City Mayor to sign for and on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government the said MOA.

NOW, THEREFORE, RESOLVE, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approve the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Tuguegarao City Government and the Department of Information and Technology (DICT) for the Free Public Internet Access Program and to grant authority to the City Mayor, Hon. Atty. Jefferson P. Soriano, to sign for and on behalf of the Tuguegarao City Government the said MOA.
