



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 52
Series of 2020

“AN ORDER EXTENDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CURFEW FROM 8PM TO 5AM UNTIL APRIL 30, 2020 IN TUGUEGARAO CITY”

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the *Local Government Code of 1991*, “states that the Local Government Units are authorized to exercise powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of general welfare;”

WHEREAS, in response to the growing concern over the outbreak of COVID-19, President Rodrigo R. Duterte through Proclamation No. 922, declared the Philippines under State of Public Health Emergency;

WHEREAS, the Office of the President through the Executive Secretary issued a Memorandum on April 07, 2020 entitled: *Extension of the Enhanced Community Quarantine over the Entire Luzon until 30 April 2020*, which directed all concerned agencies to continue implementing existing guidelines relative to the ECQ during the period of extension over the entire Luzon until 11:59 PM of 30 April 2020;

WHEREAS, a **STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY** has been declared in Tuguegarao City by virtue of Executive Order No. 15-2020, City Resolution No. 97-08-2020 and CDDRMC Resolution No. 02-2020;

WHEREAS, the allowed travel of one (1) member per household to access basic necessities must adhere to our containment and social distancing measures.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ATTY. JEFFERSON P. SORIANO, City Mayor of Tuguegarao, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Constitution and the laws, do hereby order the following:

Section 1. Curfew. Implementation of curfew from 8:00 PM to 5:00 AM within the territorial jurisdiction of Tuguegarao City is hereby extended until April 30, 2020.

Section 2. Exemptions. The following are exempted from this Order:

- a. Health workers and hospital personnel;
- b. Authorized government officials and employees, like peace officers and elected government officials in the performance of their duties;
- c. Members of the Armed Forces of the Philippines, Philippine National Police Bureau of Fire Protection, and Bureau of Jail Management and Penology;
- d. Barangay Officials and Tanods on duty;
- e. Those persons involved in emergency medical cases;
- f. Those involved in the delivery of basic necessities like food and medicine;

- g. Drivers and helpers of delivery trucks when loading and unloading of fruits and vegetables and agricultural products e.g. live hogs, cattle, broilers, eggs and the like;
- h. Funeral parlors when retrieving/servicing of cadavers;
- i. Priests and religious personnel administering religious rites at night; and
- j. Street sweepers, garbage collectors, slaughterhouse workers and meat delivery personnel on night shift duty.

Section 3. Violation. In accordance with City Ordinance No. 09-08-2020, violation of this Order shall be meted with the following penalties:

First Offense: 8 Hours Community Service
Second Offense: Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00)
Third Offense: Four Thousand Pesos (P4,000.00)

Section 4. Enforcement / Implementation. This Order shall be implemented by the Tuguegarao City Police Force, Public Safety and Security Office, Punong Barangays and Barangay Tanods in their respective jurisdictions.

Section 5. Repealing Clause. All prior issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed, amended or otherwise modified accordingly.

Section 6. Effectivity. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall subsist until the Enhanced Community Quarantine in Luzon is lifted.
