



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 61

"AN ORDER REPEALING EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 56-2020 ENTITLED 'AN ORDER PROVIDING GUIDELINES IN THE OPERATION OF MOTORCYCLE IN THE CITY TO FERRY/FETCH HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS FOR THE PERIOD OF THE GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE'"

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 56-2020 entitled "*An Order Providing Guidelines in the Operation of Motorcycle in the City to Ferry/Fetch Household Members for the Period of the General Community Quarantine*" was issued on May 8, 2020;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned executive order effectively allowed backriding on motorcycles in Tuguegarao City provided that the riders are family members living in one and the same household;

WHEREAS, Policy Content and Guidelines paragraph 4.4.1.2 of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Memorandum Circular No 2020-083 with subject "*Guidelines for Local Government Units on the Regulation of Public Transportation in Areas under General Community Quarantine and Interzonal Transportation*" which was issued on May 18, 2020 provides that the "No Backrider Policy" shall be implemented throughout the country to enable social distancing;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ATTY. JEFFERSON P. SORIANO, City Mayor of Tuguegarao, by virtue of the powers vested in me by the Constitution and the laws, do hereby repeal Executive Order No. 56-2020.


Section 1. Ban on Backriding. Backriding on motorcycles in Tuguegarao City is hereby strictly prohibited.

Section 2. Enforcement / Implementation. This Order shall be implemented by the Philippine National Police - Tuguegarao City, Public Safety and Security Office, Authorized Barangay Officials within their respective jurisdictions.

Section 3. Repealing Clause. All prior issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed as amended or otherwise modified accordingly.

Section 4. Effectivity. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
